Camp Report

DAY 1 - 23/12/2022

The annual special camping programme of National Service Scheme organized by NSS Unit 93 A. Govt College Ambalapuzha set off on 23rd December 2022 with an official inaugural ceremony presided over by the Ambalapuzha South Gramapanchayat President Smt. Kavitha. K. College Physical Education Department Associate Professor Shri. Augustine welcomed the session and then Ambalapuzha MLA Adv. H.Salam officially inaugurated the camp. Inaugural address was followed by the speech of College PTA president Shri. Martin. P.V. Commerce department Associate Professor Shri. Jithendran and College staff secretary smt. Priya Daniel sent good wishes to the volunteers for the success of the camp through their felicitations. Inaugural function was concluded with an official vote of thanks by NSS Programme Officer Shri. Shajim. M.S.



At 7 PM as scheduled, a mimicry and musical performance of Shiri. Firoz Karunagappally conducted as a part of the first offline cultural night of the special camp. Their talent expression gave more vibrance to the cultural night. PO Shri. Shajim. M. S also joined in entertaining the camp with his mimicry and singing skills. Volunteers were also joined. After dinner volunteers rejoined for the camp evaluation. Volunteer leader Jisha .J. R presented camp evaluation report. It was followed by a review by the Programme Officer in which he pointed out the rights and corrected the wrongs in evaluation.



DAY 2 - 24/12/2022

Second day the camp set off with a morning assembly. NSS Song, thought for the day, readings from the holy books and camp news report presentation were conducted respectively during the assembly. Programme Officer Shri. Shajim. M. S hoisted the NSS flag and took a few minutes to give guidance to the campers. And then the assembly was dispersed. Morning session was handled by PO Shri. Shajim about the importance of NSS and shared his experiences.

Afternoon, the session was ice breaking which was named 'Namukk Onnikkaam'. Business strategist and trainer Shri. DAY 3 - 25/12/2022

Formally, the camp sessions came to an end with the evaluation session at 10 PM.





DAY 4 - 26/12/2022

As usual, day 4 of the camp also started out with the morning assembly. Later the unit contingent walked as a procession towards the 'Musavari Bunglaw' located at Ambalapuzha under the supervision of the Programme Officer for the Sramadaan as planned. The surroundings of the health center were cleaned and sanitized by the camper volunteers from Govt College Ambalapuzha from 10.30 AM to 12.30 PM. DAY 5 - 27/12/2022
